ShoutLife Partners with Young Philanthropist – Nicolai Calabria and Free Wheelchair Mission to distribute free wheelchairs worldwide

Social Networking Site Rallies Community To Support This Important Social Cause

(San Juan Capistrano, California – April 8, 2008) ShoutLife.com – a leading social networking website that offers free profiles in a family-safe community environment – has partnered with young philanthropist, Nicolai Calabria (age 13,) to help him impact the world by delivering wheelchairs through Free Wheelchair Mission to those in need.

Nicolai Calabria, born without a leg giving him a true understanding of the need for those with a disability, climbed Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, Africa, reaching the summit in September 2007. In the process, he raised over \$100,000 for Free Wheelchair Mission. His story has been featured by The Ellen DeGeneres Show, the NBA, Good Morning America, the Boston Globe, and the Smithsonian Magazine.

ShoutLife.com, part of the FrontGate® Media family, has partnered with Nicolai to feature his story and build awareness throughout their social networking community at ShoutLife.com. Nicolai has established a goal of raising \$110,000 through his ShoutLife Friends to impact another 2,000 disabled people around the world.

“This is so simple. Wheelchairs. People who need them. \$50. A life radically changed. It’s not a question of ‘if.’ It’s a question of ‘how many?’” says Scott A. Shuford, Founder of FrontGate Media. “When I heard Nicolai’s courageous story, I immediately wanted to help him. I think the same will be true for each ShoutLife community member.”

“We’re excited to see the ShoutLife community rally around our very tangible social cause.” says Brett Trowbridge, Executive Director of Free Wheelchair Mission. “This community has ability to spread the word and ultimately, will put wheelchairs directly in the hands of people who have an excruciatingly real need that we have the ability to solve.”

In the summer of 2007, Nicolai Calabria prepared to celebrate his thirteenth birthday with an offer from his father to take him anywhere in the world on a “coming of age adventure”. Nicolai might have chosen a relaxing place to have fun as many teenagers do -- instead he chose something that would be much more memorable, life changing and the beginning of a whole new type of adventure. Inspired by the documentary *Emmanuel’s Gift*, Nicolai chose to climb Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, Africa – the tallest free-standing mountain rise in the world and highest peak in Africa at 19,340 feet high – and turn his adventure into a way of supporting the disabled community of Tanzania. Free Wheelchair Mission, a nonprofit agency highlighted in the documentary, provides free wheelchairs to the disabled poor in developing countries all over the world.
